Past Business:

Hope Over Heroin: Hannah stated November meeting, she was not able to be there. However, each location would need to provide a draft of what capacity they can handle. Tentative date to be June 16th and 17th, tentative next meeting date is 12/13. Joe mentioned Hope over Highland: \$3200 to \$3300 in expenditures. \$5039 in expenses as of 11/4 with possibly more to come. For Hope over Heroin need 20 to 30 churches. At this point, 6 churches are committed.

New Business:

Supply Reduction Committee Report: This was asked to be done due to the PMG to collect data where PMG's are currently operating. HDH had not gathered prior data per Heather. Heather states the duty is to educate the community, not to support or oppose. Stated data – when requested from HDH could not be provided. Bard stated she attended the HDH board meeting to provide concerns about the PMG. Stated one board member asked to hold on the PMG implementation to gather more information, and was denied. Adena and Ross have PMG – look at other ways to treat the pain – w/o meds. Joe stated PMG was involved in helping write the “pill mill” legislation. Barb stated there was a lack of communication between the hospital and the community.

Community Updates: Joe spoke about the Buckeye grant – family suffering from addiction. Meetings are held every Thursday @ 6 PM, for those 16 years old and up. Family of Recovery. Joe also stated that FRS has added a Rocky Fork Lake route to being 12/12. In January, they are looking at a Hillsboro route. Grant sponsored, also hoping to get corporate sponsors. \$1.00 each trip. Melinda asked about FRS selling advertisement to help cover the cost. Levy from ADAMH failed on November ballot, will be going back on, as well as Children Services did not pass, will possibly show up on ballot again – placement cost are non-negotiable for children.
