**Old Business:**

Prevention for Parents – still trying to get into the schools through PTA and Booster Clubs. Discussion was held about getting a Hidden in Plain Sight (HIP) program into the schools for parents during orientation or other parent attended event. HIP is a program that shows parents how drugs and paraphernalia are hidden in a child's room and signs of possible drug use. Melinda will email Signs of Drug Addiction video from Cuyahoga County to the members.

Post Overdose Response Team – Law enforcement has been contacted about starting the discussion of PORT in Pike County and the use of Narcan by Law Enforcement. Mike Blair with Piketon Police, the Pike County Sheriff's office and the Waverly Police Department has committed to attending a meeting to discuss the formation of an Overdose Response team. It was suggested that we also invite the Juvenile court to this meeting in January.
