Harm Reduction:

- 180 Naloxone kits were distributed in the last 4 months, FRS, SPV, law enforcement, Leesburg PD, HCSO
- SBIRT – not successful
- Healthier Buckeye extension on grant – HIPS
- Rural Opioid Grant \$250,000, Health, Prevention, care coordination, stabilization housing, long-term, and trainings.

Supply Reduction:

- Ohio AG law suit against drug companies
- Law enforcement doing a great job

Prevention:

- Jason Snyder leads the committee, updated list is current
- Hope for Highland holding an event at Rocky Fork Lake
- Red Ribbon Week in schools –PVADAMH Board will have essay again this year
